July 15, 2009, is a Court Staff Furlough Day.

The Superior Court is open. July 15, 2009, is a "court day" per the California Rules of Court. The courthouse is also open to those who have business with other courthouse agencies.

However, limited court staff is available to handle the following matters only:

- Restraining orders regarding domestic violence, elder abuse and/or civil harassment involving threats of violence or stalking;
- Tickets and citations requiring an appearance on July 15;
- Acceptance of filings through drop boxes;
- Acceptance of payments through drop boxes (no receipt will be issued today);
- Defendants responding to warrants;
- Statutorily mandated hearings;
- Emergency writs (at the Mosk Courthouse only).
